GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

All exhibitors must be **primary or secondary students (K-12)** of a school in one of the following counties: Atoka, Bryan, Choctaw, Coal, Haskell, Hughes, Johnston, Latimer, LeFlore, Marshall, McCurtain, Seminole, Pittsburg, Pontotoc or Pushmataha. **All exhibitors must own their animals ninety (90) days prior to the show date.**

Only wood shavings is to be used for bedding. No hay or straw.

There will be a protest fee of \$100. The decision of the Executive Committee will be final. The judges decisions can not be protested. **Breeds to be shown will be determined by pre entries. There must be six pre-entries to make a breed.**

MARKET SWINE REGULATIONS

No clipping of hogs on the show grounds. A copy of negative pseudorabies test must be submitted before swine can unload. ALL EXHIBITORS MUST HAVE A PREMISE ID NUMBER. Health certificates for negative Pseudorabies test will be required for all swine. Either barrows or gilts may be exhibited in the market swine classes. Maximum swine weight allowable will be 280 pounds. The classification of swine will be determined by their predominate breed characteristics. Exhibitors will be responsible for weighing their own animals and **turn in the weights by 8:30 A.M. January 26.** Ten (10) pound weigh back allowance.

Swine must exit the barn following selection of Grand and Reserve Grand Swine

DUE TO THE REGULATIONS OF THE OKLAHOMA DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, PSEUDORABIES TAG NUMBERS ARE REQUIRED ON THE ENTRY FORM. PLEASE INCLUDE THESE NUMBERS AND THE MAILING ADDRESS OF EXHIBITOR WHEN YOU SEND IN YOUR ENTRY.

MARKET LAMB REGULATIONS

All lambs must be slick shorn. No shearing in the barns. All lambs must have a full mouth of baby teeth. Pens will be on a first come basis. Either ewe or wether lambs may be exhibited in the market lamb classes. The classification of lambs will be determined by their predominate breed characteristics. **Breeds to be shown will be determined by pre entries. There must be six pre-entries to make a breed.** If there are less than six entries in a breed, they will show with the crosses. Exhibitors will be responsible for weighing their own lambs, and turn in the weights by 9:00 A.M. Friday, January 27. Five (5) pound weigh back allowance.

Lambs must exit barn following selection of Grand and Reserve Grand Prospect Breeding Doe

MARKET MEAT GOAT REGULATIONS

Meat goat wethers must be shorn to 3/8". Pens will be on a first come basis. Doe goats may be shown in the market class provided they are shorn to 3/8". Animals shown in this division may not be shown in the breeding doe division. Classes will be broken by weight. Weights must be turned in by 12:00 noon on Friday, January 27. Five (5) pound weigh back allowance.

Goats must exit barn following selection of Grand and Reserve Grand Breeding Doe

PROSPECT BREEDING DOE REGULATIONS

Does must have a full mouth of milk teeth. Meat goat does are clipped to exhibitors liking. Maximum weight for does is 160#. Pens will be on a first come basis. Weights must be turned in by 12:00 noon on Friday, January 27. Five (5) pound weigh back allowance.

Goats must exit barn following selection of Grand and Reserve Grand Prospect Breeding Doe

HEIFER REGULATIONS

All heifers must be registered and recorded in the appropriate breed association in the name of the junior exhibitor for all registered breeds. Official registration papers of all heifers will be checked by the superintendent and an exhibitor's card will be issued. **Heifers must be born after March 1, 2010.** Crossbred heifers will show together and be broken by weight. **Breeds to be shown will be determined by pre entries. There must be six pre-entries to make a breed.**

Breeds will be broken into classes as numbers warrant. Heifers must be checked in by 9 am, January 28.

STEER REGULATIONS

Steers will not show by breed. Classes will be broken by weight as numbers warrant. Prospect steers will be those steers weighing less than 900 pounds. The Champion Prospect Steer will not show for Grand Champion. Steers must be checked in by 9 am, January 28.
