

## Jonathan Gray and Trent Scrivner Combine to Shutout Paris

In the first game of the double header, Eastern's Jonathan Gray and Trent Scrivner combined to throw a shutout against Paris Junior College. The Mountaineers won 1-0. Gray earned the win and improved to 2-1 on the year. He pitched six innings and allowed just three singles. Trent Scrivner came on to pitch the final inning and earned his 7<sup>th</sup> save of the year. The Mountaineers scored their only run in the second inning. Aaron Cornell led off the inning with a single. After a sacrifice bunt and a ground out, Brandon Bargas singled to centerfield to score Cornell.

Eastern was unable to hold a late inning lead in game two. The Mountaineers held a 5-4 lead heading into the final inning, but Paris was able to score two runs and defeat the Mountaineers 6-5. With the split, Eastern moves to 11-8 on the season. Offensively, the Mountaineers were led by Chris Munoz. Munoz went 4-4 with two doubles, three runs scored and a RBI. Aaron Cornell was 2-3 with two doubles, a run, RBI and a sacrifice bunt. On the mound, Anthony Trevino and Caleb Walker pitched a combined 2 2/3 innings allowing just one unearned run. They struck out three.

This double header was the beginning of a three day – five game road trip in Texas. The Mountaineers will travel to Carthage, TX and take on Panola College tomorrow and Sunday. Tomorrow's game begins at 7:00 pm and Sunday's double header begins at 1:00 pm.
