Two sophomores make All-Oklahoma Academic Team

Two Eastern Oklahoma State College sophomores were added to the All-Oklahoma Academic Team Program recently.

Randy Bean from Broken Bow and Kelbie Kennedy, Buffalo Valley, were named by Eastern President Dr. Steve Smith to the program. Thirty-Three Oklahoma Two Year College students from across the state make up the 2010 All-Oklahoma Academic Team this year.

The All-Oklahoma Academic Team Program provides statewide recognition to outstanding two year college students. To be eligible, students must be nominated by their college president to the All-USA Academic Team. Nominees must be eligible to graduate during the 2009-2010 academic year and have a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.5. Medallions and certificates were presented to all team members.

Oklahoma is one of thirty-five states participating in the State Academic Team Program. The State Academic Teams were introduced in 1994 as a way to provide scholastic recognition to community college students, while promoting excellence at two-year colleges.

The State Academic Teams are a division of the Academic All-American Team for Community, Technical and Junior College Students, an international program sponsored annually by Phi Theta Kappa, USA TODAY and the American Association of Community Colleges. The All-Oklahoma Academic Team is designed to provide the same kind of recognition to our state's two-year college scholars by saluting their academic achievement, leadership and service.
