Three summer basketball camps to be offered at Eastern

Basketball camps will again be offered on the Wilburton campus of Eastern Oklahoma State College this summer. The first camp will be offered June 20, 21 & 22 while the second one will be June 27, 28 & 29 with the last one beginning July 11 and continuing until July 13.

The three camps will each be offered with 3 sessions to split participants by age group. Times for the separate, co-ed sessions will be ages 6-9 years from 9 a.m. till 12 noon, ages 10-12 years from 1:30 p.m. till 4:30 p.m. and ages 13-17 years from 6 p.m. till 9 p.m.

"We look forward to sharing our college and providing a great camping experience for the youth in our area," Eastern Head Basketball Coach Scott Edgar said. "We plan to teach basketball skills and fundamentals in each of the camps. Both boys and girls will be in each camp.

"We encourage every one to come and learn and practice basics for a couple of solid hours. Our goal is to polish and explain the finer points of the game along with sportsmanship."

Coach Edgar is a 30-year veteran of college basketball and his first season at the Wilburton college was a major success according to Eastern Athletic Director Aric Thomas. Many of his past teams have advanced into the NCAA tournament and nearly 20 of his former players have gone on to compete in the NBA.

The \$55 cost per camper includes a camp t-shirt and discounts are offered if campers want to attend more than one camp. No meals are provided but on-site concessions will be available.

Registration will begin one hour prior to each camp session's first day.
