STEP 1: APPLY FOR ADMISSION

STEP 2: APPLY FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is available beginning October 1 for the upcoming school year. However, you will need your family's tax information to complete the application. Eastern also provides financial assistance in the form of scholarships.

Complete the FAFSA

- Available at fafsa.gov
- Eastern's financial aid code is 003155

Priority Deadline for Scholarships

- Apply for admission to be automatically considered
- Priority deadline is Feb. 21 for competitive scholarships.

Oklahoma's Promise recipients must apply for the FAFSA every year.

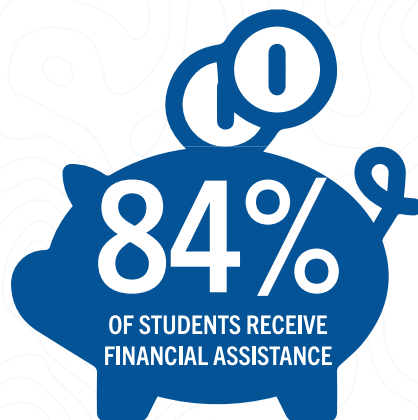
