

Alaska Respiratory Therapist Licensure Statement:

Alaska is the only US state that **does not require** RTs to be licensed. However, it is **necessary** to successfully complete a **respiratory therapy** program at an accredited college/university.

Eastern Oklahoma State College Respiratory Therapy program is an associate degree CoARC (Commission on Accreditation of Respiratory Care) accredited college that meets the standards required for licensure in all 49 states where licensure is required.

Graduates from Eastern Oklahoma State College Respiratory Therapy program also meets the standards for the state of Alaska's requirement to graduate from an accredited Respiratory Care program in order to practice.

Therefore, graduates from Eastern Oklahoma State College are eligible to apply to take the NBRC (National Board of Respiratory Care) board exams in all 50 states which qualifies them to apply for licensure in the 49 states that require them and/or to practice in Alaska which does not require a license at this time.
