ARP – American Rescue Plan
Student Quarterly Report for December 31, 2021

As required by the CRRSAA and in compliance with guidance from the U.S. Department of Education, Eastern Oklahoma State College reports its use of the Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.

1. Eastern Oklahoma State College signed and returned to the U.S. Department of Education its Certification and Agreement that the college has used, or intends to use, no less than 50% of the funds received under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES to provide Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students.
2. Eastern Oklahoma State College has received \$1,798,160 from the U.S. Department of Education for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students through the American Rescue Plan.
3. For the Quarter ending December 31, 2021, Eastern Oklahoma State College has disbursed \$568,550 in Emergency Financial Aid Grants to students through the ARP Relief Act.
4. Eastern Oklahoma State College estimates the number of students enrolled in Fall 2021, eligible to participate in programs under Section 484 in Title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 and thus eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants under Section 18004 (a)(1) to be 1,280 students.
5. For the quarter ending December 31, 2021, there has been 1,280 students who have been awarded Emergency Financial Aid Grants in amounts ranging from \$150 to \$600.
6. Method of Awarding of Emergency Financial Aid Grants:

Eligibility Requirements:

- Enrolled in Fall 2021 semester in 3 credit hours or more
- Expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the coronavirus

Awarding Requirements:

- All students have experienced various disruptions as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic including the need to purchase new technology for online courses, unexpected changes in housing costs and food, etc.
- Each student who meets the Eligibility Requirements listed above will receive a portion of the student ARP funds based on the number of credit hours each student is enrolled in that semester.

7. Communications to EOSC Students:

The following email was sent to students enrolled in Spring 2021 semester on June 16, 2021:

Dear Student:

Eastern Oklahoma State College has obtained funding from the federal American Rescue Plan Act to distribute to students to help with expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Any EOSC student who was actively enrolled in 3 credit hours or more during the Fall 2021 semester and meets the federal eligibility requirements, is eligible for these additional funds.

Please note that the funds from the American Rescue Plan are for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care) or child care.

If you have designated your direct deposit choice through www.eosc.edu then your refund should be deposited into your account by this Friday of this week.

If you have not designated your direct deposit choice there will be a paper check issued to you. Currently these checks are in Business Office on the Wilburton Campus, and you may come by any time Monday – Friday 8am to 4:30pm to pick up your check. You must bring your student ID or driver's license to pick up your check. Any check that has not been picked up by noon on Friday November 19th will be mailed to your home address.
