

**ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN SOUTHWESTERN OKLAHOMA STATE UNIVERSITY
AND EASTERN OKLAHOMA STATE COLLEGE**

**Associate of Science in Agriculture Economics (EOSC)
And
Bachelor of Business Administration, Option in Agricultural Business (SWOSU)**

OVERVIEW:

This formal program articulation agreement is made and entered into by Southwestern Oklahoma State University, hereinafter referred to as SWOSU, and Eastern Oklahoma State College, hereinafter referred to as EOSC. By this agreement, SWOSU and EOSC express a shared commitment to increasing opportunities for student access to, and success in, higher education. By clarifying transfer policies and procedures, which assure articulation between programs, the institutions seek to assist students in making a seamless transfer from the associate to the baccalaureate degree.

PURPOSE:

This agreement provides students who have earned an Associate of Science in Agriculture Economics at EOSC the opportunity to complete a Bachelor of Business Administration at SWOSU. Any EOSC student who has earned an Associate of Science in Agriculture Economics and adheres to the guidelines within this agreement is guaranteed that SWOSU will accept the A.S. degree as fulfillment of all general education requirements in the Bachelor of Business Administration, Option in Agricultural Business.

CONDITIONS OF TRANSFER:

Section I: Admissions and Matriculation

EOSC students maintaining continuous enrollment under this agreement will be afforded the same treatment and protection as SWOSU students enrolled under the Bachelor of Business Administration, Option in Agricultural Business.

Criteria for acceptance into SWOSU will be the same for transfer as for native students.

EOSC, upon request of students, will provide verification of completed courses to SWOSU through its Office of Admission and Records. The transcript of students transferring from EOSC will be evaluated by the Registrar's office at SWOSU.

Transfer students from EOSC will have access to financial aid, scholarships, and student services on the same basis as native students.

SWOSU will apply the same academic progress and graduation standards to EOSC transfer students as those applicable to native students at SWOSU.

Section II: Transfer of Credit

All courses taken at EOSC for the AS in Agriculture Economics will be accepted for transfer to SWOSU and applied to the Bachelor of Business Administration, Option in Agricultural Business requirements. Should EOSC students have more GE Classes to transfer, those will be considered. However, **EOSC students will be required to have completed at least 60 hours at SWOSU with a minimum of 40 hours at the 3000 to 4000 level upon graduation.**

Transfer students from EOSC will have junior standing at SWOSU when beginning the BBA.
